

Important Information from NCARB regarding IDP and the ARE®

Paper Experience Reports (Form 123)

The last day NCARB will accept paper experience reports (Form 123) is 30 June 2009 for the Intern Development Program. Any Form 123s received after that date will be sent back to the intern with instructions on how to submit the information through NCARB's new electronic Experience Verification Reporting system (e-EVR). Information submitted electronically is entered directly into our database by the intern and eliminates many of the common errors that occur through paper submissions. Supervisors should review and approve the report electronically, however, there is a paper submission option within the e-EVR should a supervisor not have access to email or a computer. To submit a paper form through the e-EVR, interns should select "This experience report will be printed for review, approval, and submission on paper" when they create a new experience report in the system.

ARE® 3.1 to ARE® 4.0: Site Planning and Design

Candidates who will be transitioned from ARE® 3.1 to ARE® 4.0 only need to pass ARE® 3.1's Site Planning to receive credit for ARE® 4.0's Site Planning & Design. The ARE® Transition Chart is correct as originally issued, however, the ARE® Reverse Transition chart and the *2008-2009 Handbook for Interns and Architects* were not.
